Hopefully you have all been able to have a break with the extra time due to the change of the domestic season and are now beginning preparations so you can continue to build and develop your technical and skating skills for the upcoming season.

Final Funding Distribution

The final squad funding for the season was distributed in April to squad skaters who were eligible for funding as according to the National Squad Criteria and Funding Criteria.

2009-2010 Squad

Membership in the 2009-2010 National Squad continues until the 2010 Australian Figure Skating Championships. National squad athletes must abide by the National Squad Agreement (HPF-0908-V2) up until the end of the squad season. If any requirements are not met, then the breach of agreement conditions will apply. This includes all forms returned by due dates.

ASAS Camp

The first ASAS camp (for all National Squad within singles and ice dance) will be held from 21 – 25 June at Liverpool, Sydney. Please keep these dates in mind when planning your season to ensure you can attend. Further information and forms for the camp will be distributed in the coming weeks. You will be required to submit the forms promptly so that travel and camp bookings can be finalised.

National Calendar 2010

The 2010 Australian Figure Skating Championships will be held at Icehouse in Melbourne from 25 November – 2 December as announced at the ISA AGM. Synchronized Skating will be held on the 25 and 26 November, the ISU judges seminar will be on the 27 and 28 November, and the single, dance and pair events will be held from 27 November – 2 December. The draft schedule will be distributed shortly but it is envisaged that it will be different from previous years.

Version 2 of the National Calendar for 2010 has recently been distributed and can be found on the ISA website.

2010-2011 Season Requirements

The ISU have recently released Communications 1611 (singles & pairs) and 1610 (ice dance) outlining this season's changes to levels and ice dance requirements. These are located on the ISU website www.isu.org. Further changes to rules and requirements are expected and will be announced by the ISU following decisions at the ISU Congress in mid June.
