Skaters (or Parents/Guardians of Skaters) should contact Dr Cherry Lau, [snough@hotmail.com](mailto:snough@hotmail.com), regarding any substance the Skater is using or planning to use; including all prescribed or over-the-counter medications, traditional medicines, homeopathic medicines, herbs, supplements and vitamins.

ISA would like to thank all skaters who attended the Anti-Doping Education Sessions at the 2008 Australian Figure Skating Championships. Attendance at one of these sessions was compulsory for all Junior and Senior Skaters. Skaters who were unable to attend have been contacted by the ADCO and are required to complete self-study and assessment.

Please note that the Australian Sports Anti-Doping Agency (ASADA) may conduct in-competition doping control at any State or National Competition or Championship and any skater may be selected for random testing.

At all ISU International Competitions and Championships doping control is conducted on the first three place-getters, plus one other competitor drawn at random.
