



## **Spiral Sequences for Season 2010 / 2011**

At the 2010 ISU Congress, the definition of the Spiral Sequence was redefined to the following, as ISU Communication 1619:

The spiral sequence will always be awarded a fixed Base Value and evaluated by Judges in GOE only.

In this sequence there must be at least **two** (2) spiral positions not less than three (3) seconds long each **or** only **one** (1) spiral position not less than six (6) seconds long. In case this requirement is not fulfilled, the spiral sequence will have no value.

This element also has a new abbreviation ChSp. The SOV for this new element is:

-3	-2	-1	Base	+1	+2	+3
-1.5	-1.0	-0.5	2.0	1.0	2.0	3.0

The ISA rulebook defines the Spiral Sequence as per the ISU Definition, so when the ISU definition was changed it was automatically adopted by ISA. Therefore the updated definition of a Spiral Sequence will be used for the following sections:

### **Short Programs**

- Primary Ladies
- Intermediate Ladies
- Novice Ladies

### **Free Skating**

- Preliminary Ladies
- Elementary Ladies
- Novice Pairs
