



Changes to who can sign Test Certificates

At the April 2010 Ice Skating Australia Annual General Meeting, the following changes to the wording of who is eligible to sign a skaters Certificate of Merit was passed.

THE FOLLOWING CHANGES ARE EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY

Rule 401

New paragraph after paragraph 4 and renumber paragraph 5 and 6.

New Paragraph 5

The ISA Test judge(s) who conducted the test should sign certificates of merit at the time of the test. In the event the original testing judge(s) are unable to sign the certificate, another suitably qualified ISA Test Judge(s) who has viewed the candidates' test paper will sign the certificate of merit.
