Grandfather Clause Effective

Technical Pattern Skills tested and passed before technical test taken (details below)

1st July - onward

Competitive Test Qualification Rules Effective.

Grandfather Clause:

Example #1: Skaters who have passed the current Elementary Pattern test before the 1st May 2012 will be credited as having passed the Elementary Technical Pattern Skills Test. They will start the Technical Pattern Skills level at Pre-Primary.

Example #2: Skaters who have passed the current Pre-Primary Pattern test before the 1st May 2012 will be credited as having passed the Pre-Primary Technical Pattern Skills Test. They will start the Technical Pattern Skills level at Primary.

Example #3: Skaters who have passed the Primary Technical Test (ISA Rulebook Section 4, Rule 409) and wanting to test up to the Novice Level before the 30th April 2012, the skater can test the Novice Technical Test according to the referred ISA Rule 409 without taking the Technical Pattern Skills test.

Example #4: If a skater is testing the Novice Technical Program Test after the 30th April 2012, they will need to test and pass the Technical Pattern Skills Novice Level test (test level they will start at if already passed the Primary Technical Test) before they can take the Novice Technical Program Test.
