
Title	NOVICE THEATRE ON ICE COMPETITION
By-Law No.	1243
Current By-Law	Participation in a Novice Theatre on Ice competition shall be open to financial members of a State Association in a team: <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. No member of the team shall have attained the age of 15 by July 1 preceding the competition.2. No minimum test requirement.
Proposed By-Law	Participation in a Novice Theatre on Ice competition shall be open to financial members of a State Association in a team: <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. <u>All of whose members have not attained the age of 18 years by July 1 preceding the competition and 75% of whose members have not attained the age of 16 years by July 1 preceding the competition</u>2. No minimum test requirement. <u>In the event that any calculation results in a fraction of less than one whole team member, the result will be rounded up in the event that the fraction is 0.5 or more, and rounded down when the fraction is less than 0.5.</u>
Explanatory Note	The reason for this is so that the Junior and Novice divisions are more accessible. Last year we had a few teams that wanted to enter either Novice or Junior, but due to the age of just one or two skaters, they had to enter the Open division, which changed the Open division to a bit of a free for all with Novice, Junior and Open skaters all in the same division.

Current By-Law	<p>Participation in a Junior Theatre on Ice competition shall be open to financial members of a State Association in a Team:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> All members of the team shall have attained the age of 13 by July 1 preceding the competition. Where at close of entries at least 50% of the team must have passed the ISA Preliminary Skating Test or its equivalent (ISA Rule 516.3). <p>In the event that any calculation results in a fraction of less than one whole team member, the result will be rounded up in the event that the fraction is 0.5 or more, and rounded down when the fraction is less than 0.5</p>
Proposed By-Law	<p>Participation in a Junior Theatre on Ice competition shall be open to financial members of a State Association in a Team:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <u>75% of whose members have attained the age of 13 years by July 1 preceding the competition.</u> Where at close of entries at least 50% of the team must have passed the ISA Preliminary Skating Test or its equivalent (ISA Rule 516.3). <p>In the event that any calculation results in a fraction of less than one whole team member, the result will be rounded up in the event that the fraction is 0.5 or more, and rounded down when the fraction is less than 0.5</p>
Explanatory Note	<p>The reason for this is so that the Junior and Novice divisions are more accessible. Last year we had a few teams that wanted to enter either Novice or Junior, but due to the age of just one or two skaters, they had to enter the Open division, which changed the Open division to a bit of a free for all with Novice, Junior and Open skaters all in the same division.</p>
