Jan Gardner and I worked very hard last year with ISU and the competition OC getting a U.S. competition sanctioned at the 11th hour for one of the Australia teams “iStage” to attend the Nations Cup Theatre on Ice competition held in Ann Arbor, Michigan 20-23 April 2017. With perseverance the approval came through and Coach Rebecca Rowe could finally sleep when all was confirmed. Bec had one Adult team and one Novice team compete with a total of 24 skaters between the two teams.
