Title	ADVANCED NOVICE SYNCHRONIZED SKATING CHAMPIONSHIP OF AUSTRALIA
By-Law No.	1043
Current By-Law	Participation in an Advanced Novice Synchronized Skating Championship of Australia shall be open to financial members of a State Association in a team: 1. No more than 50% of the members of which have competed at a higher level either State, National or elsewhere. 2. No member of the team shall have attained the age of 15 by July 1 preceding the competition. 3. Where at close of entries at least 75% of the team must have passed the ISA Preliminary Skating Test or its equivalent (ISA Rule 516.3) and 50% must have passed Elementary Technical Pattern Skills or Elementary Dance or its equivalent (ISA Rule 516.3). 4. In the event that any calculation results in a fraction of less than one whole team member, the result will be rounded up in the event that the fraction is 0.5 or more, and rounded down when the fraction is less than 0.5.
Proposed By-Law	<u>2. All of whose members have not attained the age of 17 years by July 1 preceding the competition and 75% of whose members have not attained the age of 15 years by July 1 preceding the competition</u>

Explanatory Note	Extending the age limit to encourage teams to compete in Advanced Novice if they have a few skaters older than the current age limit rather than having to go to the default division of Mixed Age. Does not affect the requirements to qualify for international competition.
