Title	AFFILIATION
By-Law No.	1058
Current By-Law	Members of any one Synchronized Skating Team must all be members of the same State Association. Skaters may not represent more than one State Association in the same championship or competition.
Proposed By-Law	<p>Members of any one Synchronized Skating Team must all be members of the same State Association.</p> <p>Skaters may not represent more than one State Association in the same championship or competition.</p> <p><u>Team replacements for international competition must be members of a State Association, however this may be different to that of other team members.</u></p>
Explanatory Note	Reflects what is current practice.


