



Australian Adult Test Requirements

This is the list of tests that Adult Skaters must have in order to compete in Adult Competitions in Australia. Please check with relevant competition organisers regarding any variations to this.

International event requirements may be different (including skaters being able to self select). However always check with the competition organisers to ensure you are entering the correct division.

Competition Convenors should check skaters tests levels to ensure they are competing in the correct division.

Adult skaters, whilst they cannot compete at a level above which they do not have a test for, may compete at a level lower than what they have tested. This is to take into consideration factors including time away from the sport, injuries, work commitments impacting on ability to train, etc.

All skaters must be a current financial member of a State Association when competing in Adult Events.

Division	Minimum Test Requirement
Copper	No test required
Bronze	Preliminary Pattern Test or equivalent
Silver	Elementary Pattern Test or equivalent
Gold	Basic Novice Pattern Test or equivalent
Masters	Basic Novice Pattern Test or equivalent
Elite Masters	Advanced Novice Pattern Test or equivalent
Adult Pair Skating	Preliminary Technical Skills Test or equivalent
Adult Pair Skating - Masters	Basic Novice Pair Test or equivalent
Adult Pair Skating – Elite Masters	Advanced Novice Pair Test or equivalent
