### 1. Purpose of the Communication

To ensure that all stakeholders are using the correct rules for their competition and to clarify the start of the seasons. This only applies to Junior Singles skaters, Junior/Senior Pairs, all dance categories and Junior/Senior Synchronized Skaters. All other programs do not change annually.

### 2. Application of the Communication

From 1<sup>st</sup> February 2023

### 3. Policy Statement

The start date for ISA Season is 1 February each year.as per the ISA rules. This has been the case for many years. This means that all ISA competitions must be run on ISA rules ie the 2023-2024 ISU short program rules. This should apply to Panda and Hollins Trophy.

The start date of the ISU season is 1 July each year. This means that any international competition prior to 1 July must be using 2022-2023 season short program rules. This will apply to Hollins International and Oceania.
