In my professional career I currently hold the position of Director Supply Chain Operations, South East Queensland for Queensland Health in this position I am responsible for the supply of all non-food related supplies for all Queensland Health facilities from Bundaberg in the Wide Bay region to the NSW border this includes 15 major hospitals and almost 200 staff. I have worked for Queensland Health for the past 15 years. Almost all my career has been in supply chain and logistics.

My sporting involvement started in motor sport driving rally cars in 1980. I was Queensland Rally Champion Driver in 1983 and 1986.

The Confederation of Australian Motor Sport (now known as Motorsport Australia) is the Australian controlling body for motorsport delegated by the FIA (Fédération Internationale de l'Automobile). I have been a delegate of the Motorsport Australia, Queensland State Council since 1982 and continue to be a delegate. I was Chairman of the State Council for 4 years from 1997 to 2000. I was previously a Board Member of CAMS from 2000 to 2009 including 5 years as Vice-President.

I was also a Director of Rally Australia Pty Ltd since it was founded by Motorsport Australia in 2008 until mid-2020. Rally Australia was Australia's Round of the FIA World Rally Championship.

I hold a Motorsport Australia Gold level Stewards Licence, a Silver level Event Command Licence and I am an appointed Course Checker. I was the Series Steward for the Australian Rally Championship for 7 years and was appointed by the FIA as Chairman of the Stewards at the 2015 Rallye de Nouvelle Calédonie, Asia Pacific Rally Championship Round, 2016 Rally of Whangarei, NZ Asia Pacific Rally Championship Round, 2017 Malaysian Rally Asia Pacific Rally Championship Round

I was awarded the Australian Sports Medal in 2000 by the Federal Government for service to motor sport. In 2009 I was awarded Motorsport Australia Life Membership.

My involvement in Ice Skating started at the end of 1986 when my daughter, Hayley decided to change from roller skating to ice skating. Since that time, I have been involved in the sport firstly as a parent watching on and taking her to competitions locally. She then progressed to attending AFSC events firstly in figure skating and then in both figure skating and synchronized skating. I then stepped up to the administrative side of the sport as President of the Queensland Synchronized Iceskating Club. I also took on the role of Team Leader for firstly QSIC teams and then later as Synchronized Team Leader for ISQ. I am a Life Member of the Queensland Synchronized Iceskating Club.

I have been appointed as Team Leader by ISA at ISU Synchronized Championships and International Events on numerous occasions commencing in 1997.

I was elected as ISQ Treasurer in 2012 and then as ISQ President in 2019.

I became a Board Member of Ice Skating Australia Inc. in 2016 after a casual vacancy and have since served 3 terms as an ISA Board Member.

I was a member of the LOC for the 1996 World Junior Figure Skating Championships when they were held in Brisbane. I have also been involved on the LOC for ISQ organized AFSC events for many years. I was Co-convenor of the 2022 AFSC.

I am a member of the Australian Institute of Company Directors and have a passion for governance.

I also have a passion to drive ISA forward and investigate new revenue streams and external support to help our athletes to reach greater success in their careers and hopefully reduce their financial burden.
