Adult Silver and Adult Gold Singles Category Competition Classes

Date Approved: October 2023

Effective Start Date: 3 October 2023

1. Purpose of the Communication

To advise amendment to ISA By-Law 501 introducing age Classes into Adult Silver and Adult Gold Singles categories for ISA Members' Adult competitions and championships events.

2. Application of the Communication

These age classes will apply immediately and will be offered in competition announcements for all Adult Silver and Adult Gold Singles competitions and championship events held within Australia.

3. Communication Details

Due to the growing numbers of adults participating in Adult Silver and Adult Gold single categories and varying age range of participants, ISA Board has approved for these two categories to be split into two age classes.

ISA qualifying scores for 2023 AFSC for these categories will remain in place as per ISA Communication 144 v2.

For Silver and Gold Single categories, the categories will be divided into the following age classes or if fewer than three (3) participants enter, age categories may be combined wherever possible to ensure competition:

	Silver	Gold
<u>Class I</u>	18-35 years of age as at 1 July preceding the event	18-28 years of age as at 1 July preceding the event
<u>Class II</u>	36 and older as at 1 July preceding the event	29 and older as at 1 July preceding the event
