1 Purpose of the Policy Variation

From 1 July 2020, ASADA will cease to exist as an organisation and will merge into Sport Integrity Australia – this new agency will become Australia's National Anti-Doping Organisation (NADO). Given this change, it is important the ISA Anti-Doping Policy is updated to ensure the anti-doping operations of Sport Integrity Australia are recognised.

The existing ISA Anti-Doping Policy and this variation will be updated before 1 August 2020 upon receipt of the required NADO changes.

2 Application of Policy

This policy variation applies to all people and entities encompassed by the existing ISA Anti-Doping Policy and is simply a name change variation.

3 Policy Statement

To ensure any NEW Athletes or Support Persons who become members of our sport after 1 July 2020 but before our anti-doping policy is changed to formerly reflect Sport Integrity Australia (in August), this variation document which replaces all references to ASADA with references to Sport Integrity Australia will suffice. This is simply a name change variation.

Any and all references to the:

- Australian Sports Anti-Doping Authority (ASADA) are to be read as references to Sport Integrity Australia;
- *Australian Sports Anti-Doping Authority Act 2006 (Cth) (ASADA Act)* are to be read as references to the *Sport Integrity Australia Act 2020 (Cth)*; and
- *Australian Sports Anti-Doping Authority Regulations 2006 (Cth) (ASADA Regulations)* are to be read as references to the *Sport Integrity Australia Regulations 2020 (Cth)*.
